



RULES FOR ACCOMMODATION IN THE CANARY ISLANDS OBSERVATORIES

According to the regulations decreed by the relevant Spanish administrative relative to SARS-CoV-2 authorities that you can see in the annexe at the end of this document.

1.- NATIONAL AND REGIONAL REGULATIONS

To stay in the OOCs it will not be necessary to prove that one is free of COVID-19 disease (resolution in force until 00 AM on May 31, 2022 without prejudice to extension) after the suspension of the first 4 paragraphs of Decree-Law 17/2020. In the same way, the imitative measures for the protection of health and the prevention of the spread of COVID-19 applicable at the different health alert levels are temporarily suspended. This resolution is valid until 00:00 hours on 30 April 2022 (without prejudice to the weekly evaluation of the epidemiological situation or an extension that modifies or extends the period of validity).

2.- ORM RESIDENCIA USER RULES COVID-19 (25/03/2022)

- To protect the health of users and employees in Residencia, the necessary collective protection measures have been taken to ensure compliance with the established rules. At the points of interaction of people inside the building will remain to install protective screens at the Reception desk and at the Administration office.
- All personnel inside the building should wear appropriate protective masks and should keep a distance of 1.5 meters from other personnel and users.
- Users accessing the Residencia must comply with the same recommendations regarding the use of masks and respect the 1,5 meters distance. Use of the mask along the entire area. Some cleaning points with hydroalcoholic gel have been set up in the Residencia: one at the Reception area, one at the entrance of the dining room, at the annexes and another one at the first aid room.
- The kitchen-dining room service may be operative, as long as the food is distributed in packages with specific technical health guarantees. These foods may be taken in the dining room, keeping a safe distance of 1,5 metres.
- In the dining room has been installed A CO2 to facilitate the renewal of the air in the dining room by opening the windows. There is also a control system for opening the windows in the common areas, which have mosquito nets to facilitate air renewal and prevent the enter insects.
- The Residencia has a temperature thermometer, next to the reception, recommending its use for users who enter the building.
- As for the rest of the common areas, continuous cleaning measures have been taken during the hours when the building is most crowded.
